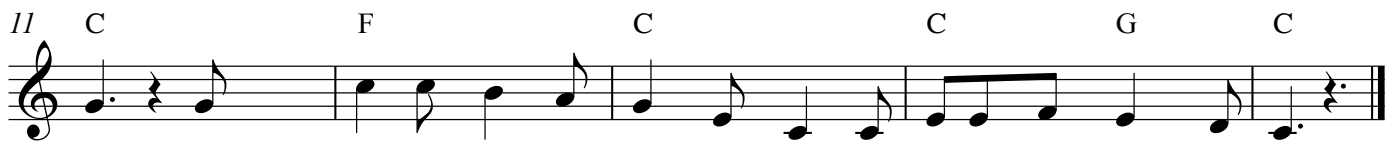
O-ver the riv-er and through the woods to Grand-moth-er's house we go! The
